Data Security and Privacy

ML Strategies understands that data security and privacy are two of the most important issues in the telecommunications, technology, and commerce space. We engage with Congressional leaders and the FTC on the development of regulations for privacy, data breach notification, and geolocation.

Cybersecurity

ML Strategies engages with Congressional committees of jurisdiction and Federal Agencies on cybersecurity to shape cybersecurity regulations to reflect clients' concerns.

Postal Reform

Broadband

Telecommunications Act Update

ML Strategies engages with the House Energy & Commerce Committee as it considers updating the Telecommunications Act for the first time since 1996.

Spectrum

ML Strategies monitors the development of spectrum policy in Congress and at the FCC. This includes efficient use of government spectrum, unlicensed use for WiFi and smart vehicle technologies, and the rules for the incentive auctions scheduled to take place in 2015.

Trade
